

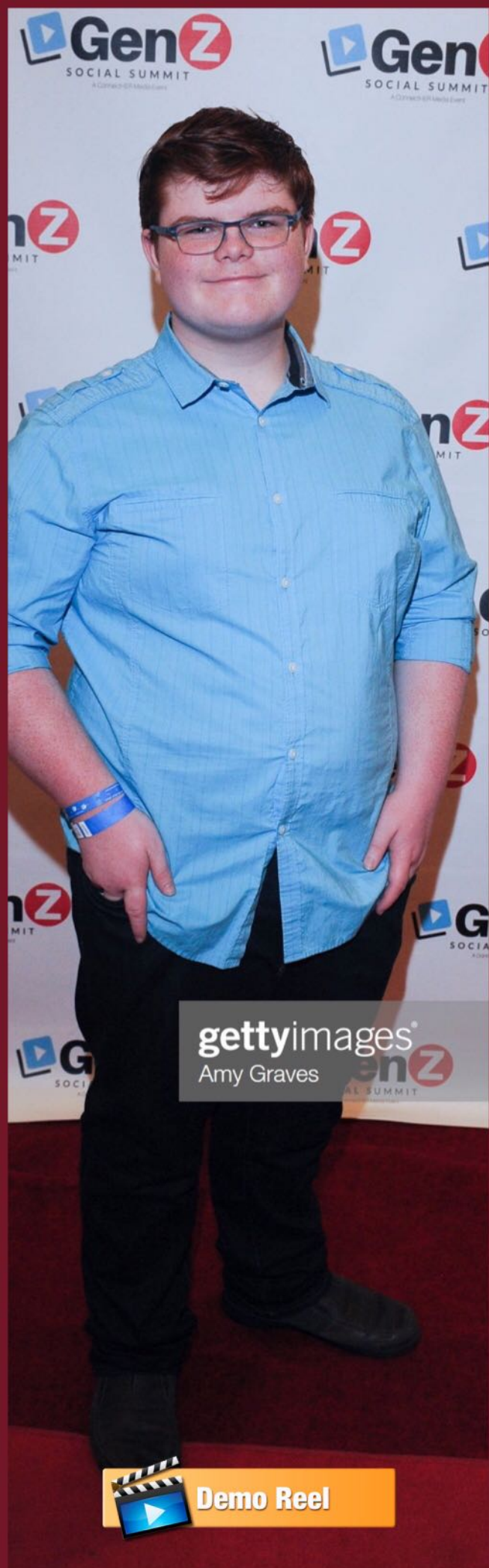


Grayson

Biography

Grayson Thorne Kilpatrick was born in Huntsville, AL. At the age of 9 he fell in love with acting after using acting as a play therapy to deal with a traumatic experience. Grayson took acting classes in his home town at Hollywood Huntsville and at Gray Studios in Nashville, TN. In the same year, Grayson made his screen debut in the feature film "Campin' Buddies". From 2013 until the end of 2015, Grayson had received 24 IMDb credits for Feature Films, Short Films and TV Series. In 2016, Grayson and his family moved to Los Angeles where Grayson has already received several more IMDb credits for various TV Series and Films. Grayson joined the Screen Actors Guild and became a member of SAG-AFTRA in February 2016, only one month after moving to L.A. Grayson has taken acting classes at Margie Haber Studio, Ivana Chubbuck Studio and private acting sessions with Disney Director Wendy Faraone. Grayson wrote/directed and starred in his own short film called "John Foley: Motivationally Speaking" which is a dedication (tribute?) to the late actor Chris Farley's skit on the SNL character Matt Foley "Living in a Van Down by the River". Grayson plays his son John Foley a new generation of motivational speakers. Grayson was nominated for best actor in a short film and won an award at the Young Artist Awards for his role as John Foley. Grayson is a Rubik's Cube guru and can be seen on "Good Morning La La Land" explaining how to solve a 3x3. Grayson has over 100 Rubik's Cubes of all shapes and sizes. Grayson even has the Ghost Cube he has solved.
